Campus access control

In the past week, we have seen a huge surge of confirmed cases of coronavirus disease (COVID-19) in countries over different continents. In response to this development, commencing **14 March 2020 (Saturday)**, the control on access to campus will be updated as follows:

Entry to campus is NOT allowed for any persons who:

- are required by the government to carry out compulsory quarantine. Please refer to the most updated list from the Centre for Health Protection (<https://www.chp.gov.hk>);
- have any fever, fatigue, cough, diarrhoea, vomiting or flu-like symptoms;
- have been in close contact with any confirmed or suspected cases of COVID-19; OR
- are having a fever as revealed in the temperature test at the campus entrances.

Colleagues are requested to notify their visitors of the above to avoid disruption of plans when entering campus. As before, please stay healthy and vigilant for the developments and find updates on HKBU Bulletin Board link (<http://ehsu.hkbu.edu.hk/2019-nCOV/>) and the Government website (www.gov.hk).
