**Submission of health declaration**

In view of the continuing spread of the novel coronavirus pneumonia around the world, we urge you to strictly comply with the preventive measures set out by the University to protect members of the University community.

Self-health declaration is one of the key measures to protect the health and well-being of members on campus. Please be reminded that all students and colleagues MUST submit the online health declaration ([HERE](#)) before the first day of return to the University campus for study or work. Resubmission of the health declaration is needed should there be any updates on their answers to the questions in the declaration. Access will be denied if the student/colleague:

- has not submitted the online form;
- has travelled to Mainland China in the past 14 days;
- has a fever cough, diarrhoea, vomiting or flu-like symptoms; or
- has in close contact with anyone diagnosed with or suspected of any respiratory disease.

We appeal to members of the University community for understanding and cooperation to ensure the best protection to all members of the University and their families.
