**Fighting COVID-19
Additional Precautionary Measures**

In the past few days, multiple local cases of COVID-19 with unknown sources of infection have been reported. In addition to hygiene and safety practices already in place since earlier this year, the following additional precautionary measures shall be implemented with immediate effect:

- Student or staff member who is required to undergo testing of COVID-19 by the Government or a doctor shall notify his/her department as soon as possible; and
- This student or staff member shall not come back to campus but shall study or work from home until negative test result is confirmed.

The online health declaration will be updated to align with the above starting 5 a.m. 10 July 2020 (Friday). Student or staff member declaring that he or she has been requested by the Government or a doctor to undergo COVID-19 testing will be denied entry to campus. For these cases, the University will carry out additional cleaning as far as practical to areas that he or she has visited before the testing was required.
