

Dear students and colleagues,

### **Confirmed COVID-19 student infection case**

The University has received a report that an undergraduate student has tested positive for COVID-19.

According to information available, the student entered the Kowloon Tong campus to attend classes from 28 to 30 September, and developed COVID-19 symptoms on 1 October. The student had sought medical consultation at a private hospital on 5 October, and was tested positive for COVID-19 in the evening of 6 October.

During the stay on campus, the student visited LT1 and LT2 at Cha Chi-ming Science Tower, AAB614, AAB705 and the Learning Commons at Academic and Administration Building, DLB721 at David C Lam Building, and Main Hall at Wai Hang Sports Centre for classes or other activities. The student has worn face mask throughout the stay on campus. Upon receiving the case report, the Estates Office has immediately arranged closure of and thorough disinfection for all the classrooms and venues concerned.

As a precautionary measure, certain classes will be conducted online. Students will be notified by their teachers individually for related arrangements.

The University is liaising closely with the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) for extra precautionary measures needed. We will update you as soon as possible if additional preventive measures that affect normal campus operations are necessary. Upon receiving advice from CHP, we will contact those who are advised to take COVID-19 tests. For enquiries, please contact the Estates Office at 3411 7997.

As COVID-19 cases with unknown infection source continue to exist in the community, please be reminded to stay vigilant and strictly observe all the recommended health protection measures on campus. All students and colleagues **MUST NOT** come to the campus if they have any respiratory symptoms or are in close contact with a confirmed case. If you develop a fever or other flu-like symptoms, you should seek medical treatment immediately. The Estates Office will continue to ensure that the disinfection measures on campus are carried out effectively on a regular basis.

Please join me in wishing the student a speedy and full recovery.
