

Dear Students and Colleagues,

### **24-hour opening for four campus entrance checkpoints**

The University community returning to campus for the resumption of face-to-face teaching began on 28 September 2020. With the ongoing implementation of various precautionary measures on campus to best safeguard the health and safety of the University community, the University is taking a cautious approach towards returning to normal University life. Starting 27 October 2020 (Tuesday), the following four campus entrance checkpoints will be open around the clock, i.e. 24 hours a day, seven days a week:

1. Pedestrian entrance, Kam Shing Road, Ho Sin Hang Campus;
2. L3, Shaw Tower, Shaw Campus;
3. L1, Academic and Administration Building (AAB), Baptist University Road Campus (BURC); and
4. G/F, Lee Shau Kee Communication and Visual Arts Building, BURC.

For society offices on L6, AAB and Yeung Shui Sang Building, the following access arrangements for students apply:

- Term time: 24 hours for office-bearers and 7 a.m. to 11 p.m. for non-office-bearers
- Term break: 24 hours for office-bearers only

We would also like to draw your attention that for the sake of the University community, all health protection measures on campus shall be strictly followed, including:

1. Complete the online health declaration before arriving at the campus. The validity of online health declaration expires at 5 a.m. daily, and a new declaration is required after 5 a.m. for access to the campus that day.
2. Undergo temperature check at the campus entrance checkpoint.
3. Wear a mask and observe good personal hygiene at all times on campus.
4. Maintain social distancing of at least 1.5 metres apart whenever possible. Except during classes, no more than four students shall gather together until further notice.

All students and staff are required to follow the health safety measures at all hours when they are inside the campus. The sustainability of a round-the-clock campus relies on the vigilance of all individuals to observe health safety rules and to minimise the risks of COVID-19 transmission within the campus.

The campus opening hours will be reviewed from time to time in response to the changing pandemic situation and the associated health safety risks.
