

Dear students and colleagues,

### **Two confirmed COVID-19 student infection cases**

I write to alert you that we have a second confirmed COVID-19 case at our university within the last 24 hours. Both cases involved undergraduate students from the Department of Sport, Physical Education and Health, and the second confirmed case is a close contact of the first student confirmed case reported earlier.

This second confirmed student developed COVID-19 symptoms on 10 November. Her last day on campus was 6 November, more than 2 days before her first symptom appeared.

According to CHP's advice, areas visited by confirmed COVID-19 patients more than 2 days before the symptoms appeared are considered to be of low risk.

The University is tracing the contacts of the second confirmed student and will inform those affected individually. Since it is highly likely that the two cases are connected, we have been taking all necessary measures to follow up with those who might have been in the same venue and have contacts with them. Meanwhile, we are also liaising closely with the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) for extra precautionary measures needed. We will update you on our follow up actions for the cases as soon as possible.

Please take all the necessary precautionary steps and stay vigilant in view of this latest outbreak.
