Confirmed COVID-19 student infection case

The University has received a report that an overseas student of the Department of Computer Science was tested positive for COVID-19.

According to information available, the student left Hong Kong on 18 November for hometown. The student had developed symptoms since 22 November, and was tested positive for COVID-19 on 23 November.

Before leaving Hong Kong on 18 November, the student resided in our student hostel on campus. As the student only developed symptoms four days after leaving the HKBU campus, our preliminary assessment is that the case has no immediate health risk to the HKBU community. Yet we will closely monitor the situation and alert you if there is any latest development with health implication to students and staff members.
