**Confirmed COVID-19 staff infection case**

The University has received a report that a staff member who works at the Hong Kong Baptist University Tsimshatsui Chinese Medicine Clinic at Humphreys Avenue was tested positive for COVID-19.

According to information available, the colleague has been on leave starting from 15 November and has not returned to the Tsimshatsui Clinic since then. On 27 November, the colleague visited the Lui Seng Chun clinic in Mong Kok for a Chinese medicine consultation and wore a face mask throughout the visit. The colleague had developed COVID-19 symptoms on 29 November, and was tested positive for COVID-19 today (2 December).

Upon receiving the case report this evening, the Estates Office has arranged closure of and thorough disinfection for the Lui Seng Chun clinic to be conducted tomorrow (3 December). The clinic will be opened again after the disinfection, subject to the advice of the Centre for Health Protection (CHP).

The University is liaising closely with CHP for extra precautionary measures needed. We will update you if further follow up actions are necessary.
