Confirmed COVID-19 student infection case

The University has received a report that a student from the College of International Education has tested positive for COVID-19.

According to the information available, the student visited the Shek Mun Campus for the last time on 7 December, and developed COVID-19 symptoms on 11 December. The student had a medical consultation on 12 December, and tested positive for COVID-19 on 13 December.

The student wore a face mask throughout the stay on campus on 7 December. As the student has not returned to campus since 7 December, and has no contact with any member of the university community outside campus, our preliminary assessment is that the case has no immediate health risk to the HKBU community.

Yet we will closely monitor the situation and alert you if there is any latest development with health implication to students and staff members.
