**Fighting COVID-19
Campus access control**

The University has been closely monitoring the COVID-19 pandemic situation and reviewing the prevailing campus access control measures. In response to the recent Government's arrangements for COVID-19 tests, the health declaration of campus access control has been updated in boldface below **with effect from 28 December 2020 (Monday)**:

Student / staff member remains NOT allowed to enter the campus if he / she:

1. is currently under compulsory quarantine by the HKSAR Government or waiting for the result of COVID-19 test which is required by the HKSAR Government or doctor;
2. has any COVID-19 symptoms including fever, fatigue, cough, diarrhoea, vomiting and flu-like symptoms; OR/AND
3. has been in close contact in the last 14 days with a person who is a confirmed COVID-19 case, or undergoing compulsory quarantine, or waiting for the result of COVID 19 test as required by the HKSAR Government or a doctor (**except the precautionary COVID-19 test for specified occupations**); **and has not yet obtained a negative COVID-19 test result from a laboratory recognised by the HKSAR Government after the close contact with the above person.**
