

Dear students and colleagues,

Confirmed COVID-19 student infection case (12 January 2021)

The University has received a report that an Associate Degree student with concentration studies in Business Administration from the College of International Education (CIE) has tested positive for COVID-19.

The student is a close contact of another CIE student with concentration studies in Visual Arts who had tested positive for COVID-19 on 9 January. The student was under compulsory quarantine since 5 January, and tested positive for COVID-19 today after having developed COVID-19 symptoms last night.

According to the information available, the last day the student entered campus was 31 December 2020, with no symptom throughout the period. The student wore a face mask while staying on campus except when eating, and all the venues visited were disinfected on 4 January 2021. The venues were reopened after disinfection.

The University will closely monitor the situation, and liaise with the Centre for Health Protection regarding any extra precautionary measures needed. We will update you on our follow up actions, if any, regarding the case as soon as possible.
