**Preliminary positive COVID-19 student infection case
(13 January 2021)**

The University has received a report that a student of the Bachelor of Social Sciences (Honours) in Sport and Recreation Leadership programme delivered at the College of International Education has preliminarily tested positive for COVID-19.

According to the information available, the last time the student entered the Shek Mun campus was on 4 December 2020, and the student had no COVID-19 symptoms. The student had developed COVID-19 symptoms on 10 January 2021, and has preliminarily tested positive for COVID-19 yesterday.

As the student has not returned to campus since 4 December 2020 and has had no contact with any member of the university community outside campus in the past 14 days, based on Centre for Health Protection's advice on similar cases, our preliminary assessment is that the case has no immediate health risk to the HKBU community. Yet we will closely monitor the situation and alert you if there is any latest development with health implication to students and staff members.
