### **Update on Work Arrangements**

In view of the latest developments of the COVID-19 situation, the University operation is now going back to normal and in full operation. Accordingly, work-from-home arrangements will cease to apply and colleagues are expected to resume their duties at their workplace. Staff members with special needs or prohibited from entering the campus due to one's high risk of COVID-19 should discuss with their supervisors for alternate work arrangements where operational needs permitting.

The University will continue to follow the guidelines issued by the Centre for Health Protection on infection control measures and adopt the required precautionary measures to mitigate the disease transmission risks, and to protect our University community's health and well-being. In this regard, the requirement of health declaration, denied entry for high risk persons and mandatory mask wearing requirement remain in force (click [1/2](#)).

The University Administration continues to closely monitor the situation and give necessary advice on the required precautionary measures and necessary changes to work arrangements where needed.
