**Fighting COVID-19  
Campus access control**

The University has been closely monitoring the COVID-19 pandemic situation and reviewing the prevailing campus access control measures. In response to the recent Government's arrangements for COVID-19 tests, the health declaration of campus access control has been updated in boldface below **with effect from 25 March 2021 (Thursday)**.

Student / staff member will NOT be allowed to enter the campus if he / she:

1. is currently under compulsory quarantine by the HKSAR Government or waiting for the result of COVID-19 test which is required by the HKSAR Government or doctor **(except the precautionary COVID-19 test for specified occupations or those who are working at specified business and premises)**;
2. has any COVID-19 symptoms including fever, fatigue, cough, diarrhoea, vomiting and flu-like symptoms; OR/AND
3. has been in close contact in the last 14 days with a person who is a confirmed COVID-19 case, or undergoing compulsory quarantine, or waiting for the result of COVID-19 test as required by the HKSAR Government or a doctor (except the precautionary COVID-19 test for specific occupations **or those who are working at specified business and premises**); and has not yet obtained a negative COVID-19 test result from a laboratory recognised by the HKSAR Government after the close contact with the above person.
