



Dear students and colleagues,

Confirmed COVID-19 student infection case (27 March 2021)

The University received a report earlier this evening that a student from the Faculty of Social Sciences had tested positive for COVID-19.

According to the information available, the student attended two lectures at the Kowloon Tong campus on 18 and 22 March at CVA109 at the Communication and Visual Arts Building and LMC512 at Lui Ming Choi Centre respectively. The student had worn face mask throughout the stay on campus, and was tested positive for COVID-19 today (27 March).

Upon receiving the case report, the Estates Office has arranged for the closure and thorough disinfection of all the classrooms and venues concerned.

The University is liaising closely with the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) to trace those who have been in contact with the confirmed student. CHP requested the University to provide names and contact of students and teachers who had attended the same course as the student concerned for their tracing of close contact. We will update you on our follow up actions, if any, regarding the case as soon as possible.
