**INOCULATION AGAINST COVID-19
CoronaVac vaccination at the University Health Services Centre**

Vaccination by way of injection of CoronaVac 克爾來福 will be made available to our staff and students at the University Health Services Centre on Level 5 of Ho Sin Hang Campus starting from 10 May 2021. Telephone bookings can now be made by calling 3411 7447.

Getting the vaccine

If you wish to take the vaccine injection at the University Health Services Centre, you must first confirm through telephone booking. When visiting the Centre for the vaccine, you must bring your HKID card or passport in addition to your student / staff / affiliate card.

Arrangement for persons getting the 2nd dose vaccine

If you have already received the 1st dose of vaccine through other channels and wish to receive the 2nd dose from the University Health Services Centre, you must bring along your COVID-19 Vaccination Record. The University or the University Health Services Centre does NOT have the responsibility to check your vaccination history and it will not conduct such check. It is solely your responsibility to provide the record of any earlier vaccination.

Important notes

The supply of vaccines available at the University Health Services Centre is limited, and bookings will be confirmed on a first come, first served basis.

Information about suitability, efficacy, side effects and potential adverse reactions of vaccination have been provided by the Centre for Health Protection (CHP). Please visit the government [website](#) before making the decision to receive the vaccine.

A list of health conditions which will cause a person to become unsuitable or dangerous to receive the vaccine has been provided by the CHP at this [website](#). It is your own responsibility to study the information carefully and ascertain your suitability before booking for the vaccine. If in doubt, you must consult your own doctor before making the decision.

Nothing stated or referred to in this email or the vaccination arrangements referred herein shall be construed as an advice, recommendation or encouragement given by the University or any of its personnel to any party to decide to receive the COVID-19 vaccines or not, nor shall it be relied on by any party for making such decision.
