

Dear Students and Colleagues,

Update on Health Declaration

The University has been closely monitoring the COVID-19 pandemic situation and reviewing the prevailing campus access control measures. In response to the recent Government's requirements imposed on inbound travellers, the University has assessed and decided that students or staff members who are required to carry out COVID-19 tests *after* completing the mandatory quarantine and allowed to proceed to self-monitoring stage need not be banned from campus.

The health declaration of campus access control will be updated in boldface below **with effect from 20 August 2021 (Friday)**:

Student / staff member will NOT be allowed to enter the campus if he / she:

1. is currently under compulsory quarantine by the HKSAR Government; or
2. is currently required by the HKSAR Government or a doctor to undergo compulsory COVID-19 test EXCEPT
 - a. precautionary COVID-19 test for specified occupations or those who are working at specified business and premises, or
 - b. **compulsory COVID-19 test for inbound travellers**; or
3. in the last 14 days, has been in close contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case or a person who is either
 - a. currently undergoing compulsory quarantine, or
 - b. currently required by the HKSAR Government or a doctor to undergo compulsory COVID-19 test EXCEPT
 - i. precautionary COVID-19 test for specified occupations or those who are working at specified business and premises, or
 - ii. **compulsory COVID-19 test for inbound travellers**; or
4. has any COVID-19 symptoms including fever, fatigue, cough, diarrhoea, vomiting and flu-like symptoms.
