**Health Declaration  
New Features for Uploading Vaccination or COVID-19 Test Record**

Further to the announcement by the Vice-President (Administration) and Secretary on “Stepping Up COVID-19 Control Measures for Health and Safety on Campus” on 25 August 2021, we write to advise that you can now upload your COVID-19 vaccination record or test result via the Health Declaration Form on the HKBU mobile app.

To meet the implementation date of 1 October 2021 for the stepping up COVID-19 control measures for health and safety on campus, it is strongly recommended that you upload your vaccination record via the Health Declaration Form now if you are already vaccinated. The uploading is very easy and the steps are self-explanatory. **You will only need to do it once.**

For those who have not been vaccinated yet, it is recommended that you make your bookings on the COVID-19 Vaccination Programme website ([Link](#)) as soon as possible. You might wish to consult your doctor to ascertain your suitability before you get vaccinated.

If you are not able to obtain the second dose of vaccine on or before 14 days from the day you need to enter campus, you will need to get a negative result for a COVID-19 test carried out by a Government recognised route for testing ([Link](#)) in the last 14 days and upload the negative result via the Health Declaration Form before you enter the campus. Please note that the testing and uploading of results must be repeated at least every 14 days if you need to continue access to campus.

We thank you in advance for your support to fight the pandemic.
