REMINDER

“Stepping Up COVID-19 Control Measures for Health and Safety on Campus”

Please be reminded that starting **25 October 2021 (Monday)**, students and staff members entering the University campuses must either be fully vaccinated for 14 days or more, or possess a negative result of a COVID-19 test carried out within 14 days of the date of access. You may refer to the announcements by the Vice-President (Administration) and Secretary on 25 August 2021 ([Link](#)) and 13 September 2021 ([Link](#)) for more details.

Your COVID-19 vaccination record or the negative result of a COVID-19 test carried out within 14 days of your access to the campus shall be uploaded through the Health Declaration on the HKBU mobile app to identify your eligibility for entering the campuses.

Commencing 25 October 2021, all card readers at the campus entrances will indicate green light **to allow entry only if:**

- your vaccination record has been uploaded, OR the negative result of a COVID-19 test carried out within 14 days has been uploaded; **AND**
- daily online health declaration has been completed.

The requirement to upload vaccination record and COVID-19 test result is to protect the health and safety of the University Community. Persons making false declaration may be subject to disciplinary actions or liable for legal action.

All personal information collected will be handled in accordance with the prevailing University’s policy.
