## REMINDER

### Control Measures for Invited Visitors on and after 25 October 2021

Commencing **25 October 2021 (Monday)**, visitors who are going to **stay on campus for 4 hours or more** on the day of visit must either be fully vaccinated for 14 days or more, or possess a negative result of a COVID-19 test carried out within 14 days of the date of visit. You may refer to the announcements by the Vice-President (Administration) and Secretary on 25 August 2021 ([Link](#)) and 13 September 2021 ([Link](#)) for more details.

If you have registered for your invited visitors through the Visitor Registration System and they need to stay on campus for 4 hours or more on the day of visit, please remind them to upload their COVID-19 vaccination records or negative test records via the online Health Declaration Form in order to enter the campus.

The requirement to upload vaccination record and COVID-19 test result is to protect the health and safety of the University Community. Persons making false declaration may be liable for legal action.

All personal information collected will be handled in accordance with the prevailing University's policy.
