Teaching and Learning Arrangements for Semester 2, 2021/22

Warm greetings to you all!

As Semester 1, 2021/22 is coming to an end, I would like to update you with the teaching and learning arrangements for Semester 2, 2021/22.

As the COVID-19 situation is stable in Hong Kong and there has been close to zero local confirmed case in the past months, the University decides that face-to-face teaching and learning will continue in Semester 2, 2021/22. To enhance students' learning after the scheduled classes, the practice of video recording and archive of lectures will also continue.

We understand that some students may not be able to return to campus in time for Semester 2 due to factors beyond their control such as travelling restrictions and quarantine requirement. These students should inform the course instructors concerned of the reason(s) for late arrival, the expected arrival date, and provide supporting documents as far as practicable.

To take care of these students, course instructors are invited to deliver mixed mode classes or make other special arrangement to ensure that students' learning would not be adversely affected. Research postgraduate students should confirm the arrangements with the Principal Supervisor. However, same as Semester 1, such special arrangement is a temporary provision which is meant to support students during their involuntary absence from classes.

All students who are now outside Hong Kong must make your travel plan immediately to allow sufficient time for quarantine and vaccination so that you can safely return to the campus before classes for Semester 2 starting on 10 January 2022.
