### **Stepping Up COVID-19 Control Measures for Health and Safety on Campus**

In view of the recent development of the pandemic, the University is set to further step up its health and safety control measures. Starting from 10 January 2022 (Monday), students, staff members, contractors and visitors (except those who would only stay on campus for less than 4 hours on his/her day of visit) entering the University campuses must either be fully vaccinated for 14 days or more, or possess a negative result of a COVID-19 test carried out within **7 days** of the date of access.

The following arrangement will be implemented:

- 1) Negative results of COVID-19 test uploaded via the HKBU Mobile App at or before 9 January 2022 (Sunday) 23:59 will be valid for 14 days for campus access.
- 2) Negative results of COVID-19 test uploaded via the HKBU Mobile App after 10 January 2022 (Monday) 00:00 will be valid for 7 days for campus access.
- 3) Staff members and students who are fully vaccinated<sup>[Note]</sup> (i.e. have completed the vaccination course) for 14 days and have uploaded the relevant vaccination record via the HKBU Mobile App will not be affected by the above.

Opening hours and measures at the University's catering outlets and facilities will be adjusted in accordance with the announcement made by the Government earlier today. The University will further review and update its health and safety policies as and when the Government's policies are further revised. Staff members and students who are not vaccinated against COVID-19 are highly encouraged to consider receiving vaccination to safeguard the health and safety of the University community.

[Note]:-

- Fully vaccinated means the suggested dosage has been administered in accordance with the relevant guidelines of a COVID-19 vaccination course for 14 days.
- In general, completing the vaccination course involves receiving two doses of CoronaVac (SinoVac) vaccine OR two doses of Comirnaty (BioNTech) vaccine, except for persons previously infected with COVID-19, who are to receive one dose of vaccine.
- For persons aged 12 to 17, they may be deemed to have completed the COVID-19 vaccination course after receiving one dose of Comirnaty (BioNTech) vaccine.
- For individuals whose vaccines were administered outside Hong Kong, apart from the COVID-19 vaccines already recognised for use in Hong Kong, other vaccines included on this list are also accepted. [Click here for the “List of COVID-19 Vaccines Recognised for Specified Purposes”](#)
