Update on Teaching and Learning Arrangements for Semester 2, 2021/22

My warmest greetings to you all!

In view of the latest Government announcement on tightening the health safety measures, I wish to provide an update on the teaching and learning arrangements in Semester 2, 2021/22 which will start on 10 January 2022.

Face-to-face teaching will continue. However, under the new COVID-19 measures, it is likely that some students will have genuine difficulties to return to the campus due to factors beyond their control such as compulsory testing and mandatory quarantine. Students should promptly inform their course instructors of such situation, with supporting documents as far as practicable. Instructors will adopt mixed-mode teaching (i.e. face-to-face teaching synchronously with online teaching), or make other special arrangements, to ensure that students' learning will not be adversely affected.

Students who are now outside Hong Kong **MUST** make arrangement to return to Hong Kong without further delay. Please pay attention to the boarding, quarantine, vaccination and testing arrangements before your departure. Important information for inbound travelers can be found [here](#).
