Clarification of access arrangement for students and staff required by Government to undergo mandatory testing

Due to the recent development in the pandemic, more people including our students and staff might be required to undergo multiple COVID-19 tests under Cap. 599J. We would like to provide the following clarifications regarding the campus access arrangement for these people.

Student or staff required by law to carry out multiple COVID-19 tests

Student or staff who is required to carry out multiple compulsory COVID-19 tests by the Government should not come back to campus until a negative result of his or her first test is available.

Once a negative result of the first test is available, the student or staff may enter campus subject to fulfilling other campus access requirements like completing the health declaration and uploading of vaccination or negative test result.

Student or staff in close contact with a person who is required by law to carry out multiple COVID-19 tests

Similar principle applies. The student or staff should not come back to campus until a first negative result of the person needing testing is available.

Once a negative result of the person needing testing is available, access to campus for the student or staff is not affected.

Student or staff in close contact with a person who is required by law to carry out precautionary COVID-19 tests because of his or her specified occupation or work premises (like health workers, catering staff, staff of sports premises, etc.)

Access to campus for the student or staff is not affected.
