**Preliminary Positive COVID-19 Student Infection Case  
(12 January 2022)**

The University has received a report that a student from the School of Continuing Education's Bachelor of Nursing (Honours) programme has preliminarily tested positive for COVID-19.

According to the information available, the student entered the Kowloon Tong campus to attend classes from 10 to 12 January. During the stay on campus, the student visited SCE701 and SCE709 at the Madam Chan Wu Wan Kwai School of Continuing Education Tower for classes, female toilet on the 2/F of the Main Library, bench outside the Main Library and Student Welfare Shop at the Academic and Administration Building.

Upon receiving the case report, the Estates Office has arranged for the closure and thorough disinfection of all the classrooms and venues concerned.

As a precautionary measure, certain classes will be conducted online. Students will be notified by their teachers individually for related arrangements.

The University is liaising closely with the Centre for Health Protection (CHP) regarding any extra precautionary measures needed. We will update you on our follow up actions, if any, regarding the case as soon as possible.
