



## Further update on Health and Safety Precautionary Measures on Campus

Dear Students and Colleagues,

In response to the government's announcement on 14 January 2022 regarding the extension of tightening measures against COVID-19, the following health and safety precautionary measures for the University premises will be continued:

### Extended from now until 3 February 2022 (Thursday)

1. All sports facilities, fitness centres and swimming pool will be closed for physical sports activities;
2. Premises with PPE licence, i.e. Academic Community Hall and Tsang Chan Sik Yue Auditorium (AAB 201) will be closed;
3. Dining in will not be allowed after 18:00 for all catering outlets; and
4. All Academic/Learning Commons will not open overnight (please refer to the opening hours of individual venue provided on the University web page or HKBU mobile apps).

For events that will take place on campus, organizers shall change the mode to on-line as far as possible. Events serving mainly visitors, or those that will congregate many participants shall be avoided. Estates Office will approach individual organizers for exact arrangement.

The University will further review and update its health and safety precautionary measures as and when the Government's policies are further revised.
