Online Teaching till 19 February 2022

In view of the spread of COVID-19 cases in the community, the University has decided that all classes be conducted online for another two weeks from 7 February to 19 February 2022 (both days inclusive). During this period, all on-campus face-to-face teaching and learning activities will be suspended.

Classes with practical/lab-based work which requires face-to-face instructions will be suspended. Make-up classes will be arranged after the resumption of face-to-face instructions where possible.

Though the pandemic situation is still volatile, we understand that long term planning on the teaching mode is needed. We aim at arriving a decision on the teaching mode for the rest of the semester before 19 February 2022.
