Confirmed COVID-19 staff member infection case (9 February 2022)

The University has received a report today that a staff member of the Dr Ng Tor Tai International House (NTT) has tested positive for COVID-19.

According to the information available, the last time the colleague entered NTT on the Kowloon Tong campus for duty was on 31 January. The colleague developed COVID-19 symptoms on 7 February 2022 and has tested positive for COVID-19 today.

As the colleague's last entry to campus was on 31 January and has had no close contact with any member of the university community in the past seven days, based on Centre for Health Protection's advice on similar cases, our preliminary assessment is that the case has no immediate health risk to the HKBU community. Yet we will closely monitor the situation and alert you if there is any latest development with health implication to students and staff members.
