

Further update on health and safety precautionary measures on campus

Dear Students and Colleagues,

The number of COVID-19 cases in Hong Kong has continued to surge in recent weeks. Following the Government's extension on health safety control measures on scheduled premises, the arrangements listed below for the University premises will continue to apply until further notice:

1. All sports facilities, fitness centres and swimming pool are closed for physical sports activities;
2. Premises with PPE licence, i.e. Academic Community Hall and Tsang Chan Sik Yue Auditorium (AAB 201), are closed;
3. Dining in is not be allowed after 18:00 for all catering outlets; and
4. All Academic/Learning Commons is not open overnight (please refer to the opening hours of individual venues provided on the University web page [\(Link\)](#) or HKBU Mobile app).

The Vice-President (Teaching and Learning) announced on 10 February 2022 that face-to-face teaching and learning activities are suspended until the end of the semester [\(Link\)](#). For events that are planned to be held on campus during the rest of this semester, the following arrangement shall apply:

1. For events that will take place on campus, organisers shall change the mode to online as far as possible.
2. All face-to-face events on campus shall be subject to approval by the Risk Management Team. Applicant shall provide justifications for consideration.

The University will further review and update its health and safety precautionary measures as and when the Government's policies are further revised.
