Health and safety measures for normal lectures, classes and tutorials

Please be advised that the following health and safety measures for lectures, classes and tutorials have been implemented with immediate effect.

Campus access control and health declaration

The campus access control and health declaration will continue to be in place. Please refer to the latest announcement on Vaccine Pass requirements for campus access on 19 April 2022 ([LINK](#)) for details.

Ventilation in classrooms

Ventilation rate for all teaching venues has been optimised to maximise fresh air circulation.

Seating in classrooms

Maintaining social distancing as far as possible can lower the risk of spread of disease. Therefore, students shall sit as far apart from each other as possible in classrooms.

Arrangement inside classrooms

Mask must be worn at all times, and there shall be no drinking or eating in classrooms.

Hand sanitisers are provided to each and every classroom for use by colleagues and students. Apart from cleaning their hands, students and colleagues are also welcome to use the sanitisers to wipe the worktops as they feel necessary.

Disposable microphone covers are also provided on the lecterns of classrooms for use by teachers and students.

Ongoing hygiene measures

Various hygiene measures are being implemented to protect the well-being of the University community. Worktops and seats of all used classrooms will be disinfected every evening. Frequency of cleaning the campus has also been increased in general.
