### **Use of LeaveHomeSafe Mobile App on Campus**

To facilitate the gradual resumption of normal campus life, the requirements of health declaration and visitor registration for campus access will be lifted. Starting from **8 October 2022 (Saturday)**, the University's venue QR code designated for the *LeaveHomeSafe* mobile app will be displayed at all campus entrances. You are requested to scan the QR code using LeaveHomeSafe before entering the campus.

*Campus users are still required to fulfil the [Vaccine Pass](#) requirements when:*

- entering scheduled premises, such as sports facilities and catering premises, specified under the Prevention and Control of Disease (Requirements and Directions) (Business and Premises) Regulation (Cap. 599F); and
- attending events involving more than 150 participants with external guests. The relevant requirements for attending events will be notified by event organisers separately.
