Remark:

* A highly toxic chemical is defined by the U.S. Occupational Health and Safety Administration (OSHA) as a chemical that falls in any of these three categories:

1. LD50(Lethal Dose causing 50% death of test animals) of or less than 50mg/kg when administered orally.
2. LD50 of or less than 200mg/kg when administered by continuous skin contact for 24 hours.
3. LC50 in air of or less than of 200ppm or 2mg/L when administered by continuous inhalation for one hour.

The personal data collected in this form is used to register the highly toxic chemical users with EHS. The data in this form would be disclosed to other party for the purpose of arranging medical examination.
